



# FAMILY GUIDE

UMVA is excited to host you and your family to enjoy what is normally adults only. We are very intentional about creating memorable experiences for all our guests, including the little ones. We've crafted the below guide to ensure you have an amazing experience.

Family Days aren't just for families with kids, we encourage grandparents and friends of the family to come as well.

Our pricing during Family Days is simple: Kids under 5 are free. Kids 5-12 are \$75. Kids 12+ are charged at normal rates

## WHAT WE DO HAVE OR PROVIDE:

- **Flexible dinner time:** dining is family style vs. communal dining. Instead of our normal 7pm start time, we offer dinner from 6PM-9PM.
- **Tasty food accommodating many dietary preferences.** Chefs can prepare special meals for kids including mashed fruit and vegetables.
- **Board games & 55" TV:** (monopoly, connect 4, fast track, etc.)

## BE SURE TO BRING YOUR OWN:

- Extra beds/bassinets/Pack 'n' Plays
- Highchairs
- Wash basins/infant baths
- Childcare services
- Playpen for mobile babies and toddlers

## DINING

- Breakfast pastries, juices and cereals are available from 8AM. Hot breakfast can be ordered on arrival
- Lunch can be ordered anytime after breakfast and is available from 12-2PM.
- As families have different dining times, dinner will be served 6-9PM and brought out when you are ready. Please let the host know what time you would like your meal and any special requests. Dinners will be a 3 course meal (appetizer, main course and dessert) vs. a 4 course meal.

## ACTIVITIES

- Due to risk of Schistosomiasis (bilhazia), we do not advise anyone swims in the lake.
- Kayaking is available for children 14 and up. Children under 14 may be accompanied by an adult in tandem kayaks only. Life jackets are required at all times. UMVA supervision is required at all times while on the water.
- Tennis lessons are available upon request (must be booked 24 hours in advance). We have kids racquets available.
- Studio has a 55" TV with netflix that can stream movies for those stormy days

## PRO TIPS FROM OTHER FAMILIES:

- If you need to use a baby monitor, request rooms 3 or 5 which are closest to the dining area.
- UMVA is nestled into the wilderness with all types of plants and animals around. The design also has some high areas with drops as well as the lakefront, keep an eye on your kids when not in the buildings. The terrain is not suitable for kids bikes, rollerblades or scooters (??)
- The deck area is enclosed with a wire fence that small children could slip under, be extremely vigilant with small babies who are rolling or crawling, and better yet bring a playpen or pack 'n' play.
- The UMVA team is happy to help with carriages, strollers, etc. just let them know. Please ask our team if you can drive to the roundabout to temporarily offload all you kid's gear!
